Enclosed please find worksheets for this summer's reading requirements.

Grades 9-10 will be reading *Silas Marner* for their classic book. Grades 11-12 will be reading *A Tale of Two Cities*. These books should be available in any town library; however I have also seen full texts available online so that the student can read the book right on the computer.

For a Christian biography, all grades will be reading *Quiet Strength* by Tony Dungy. I believe this book will be beneficial because it is about a Christian living in the modern world and it describes how a Christian can use his secular job to serve the Lord. This book may be available through your town library, especially if you use inter-library loan. If not, I have seen it for sale on amazon.com for less than \$1; perhaps you could even arrange to share the book with another student/family.

If a student has already read one of the assigned books, please contact me through email to find a different book.

These books and worksheets should be completed and turned in during the first week of school in September. Please plan to finish reading quickly rather than waiting until the end of the summer. Also, please sign the pledge statement at the bottom of each worksheet if you finished your reading.
